Dear Parents/Carers

Did you know – just registering your child for Free School Meals means that the school gets extra money?

The percentage of our pupils who are eligible for a free school meal has become more of an important statistic over the past two years. For every child registered at Argoed High School, the school receives approximately £1050 (2015). This will be used to support your child with their learning. Therefore it is essential that those pupils who are entitled to a free school meal are registered at school. To ensure your child and others do not miss out, please complete the registration slip below.

How does it work?

- 1. First, check if you qualify it is not just if you are unemployed, so please look at the list on the next page.
- 2. Registering is quick and easy if you think you qualify, contact Mrs Davies in the school office, who will help you register.
- 3. If you want your child to have a free, healthy meal at lunchtime that is great your child will get a free meal and the school receives approximately £1050 to support learning.
- 4. If you do not want your child to have the school meals they can continue as normal as long as you qualify and are registered, the school still receives the funding.

Will people know my child is on free school meals?

This information is treated as confidential, money is added to your child's lunch account automatically.

Claiming free school meals will not affect any other benefits you are claiming.

Do I qualify?

Your child(ren) may be eligible to receive free school meals if you are in receipt of any of the following:

- ✓ Income Support
- ✓ Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- ✓ Child Tax Credit but only those who are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and whose annual income (as assessed by the Inland Revenue) does not exceed £16,190 (subject to annual review)
- ✓ Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- ✓ Employment Support Allowance (income related)
- ✓ Disability Support
- ✓ The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- ✓ Working Tax Credit 'run-on' the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- ✓ Universal Credit.

For a small number of parents in receipt of Child Tax Credit, as detailed above, you will be required to complete a free school meal application form, these are available on line at www.flintshire.gov.uk or from the school office.
